ORDER

The above captioned petition for judicial review of the April 30, 2015 decision of the Board of Liquor License Commissioners of Baltimore City was heard on October 16, 2015. The Board decision denied renewal of petitioners' adult entertainment business license (2000 Eastern Avenue - The Big Easy) for the period beginning July 1, 2015, after holding a hearing under the terms of Baltimore City Code Article 15 § 1-14(d) in response to objections to renewal. As more fully set forth in the court's decision, the court concludes that the hearing was premature because no renewal application had been filed, and in light of the terms of Article 15 § 1-14(b)(1), which provides that renewal applications for adult entertainment business licenses may not be filed more than 60 days before the license expires on June 30. Because the period to submit the renewal application for the period beginning July 1, 2015 has passed, the court will order that the renewal application may be filed within thirty days from the date of this order, with a concomitant extension for the filing of objections. Accordingly, it is this 19th day of October, 2015, for the reasons stated on the record

ORDERED that the decision of Board of Liquor License Commissioners of Baltimore City dated April 30, 2015 is REVERSED, and the case is REMANDED for further proceedings consistent with this order; and it is further

ORDERED that petitioners may file an application for the renewal of the adult entertainment business license within 30 days of the date of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that written objections to the adult entertainment business renewal application pursuant to Baltimore City Code Article 15 § 1-14(d)(1) may be filed within 30 days of the filing of the application; and it is further

ORDERED that costs are waived.
