(e) Qualified Voters: James Dipino, Christopher Palazzi, and Michael Joseph are qualified Baltimore City voters.

(f) Zoning: Applicants have applied for a USE permit, for the continued use of the property restaurant with live entertainment, and outdoor table service, and to expand premise to include units 110, and 111.

(g) Corporate Standing: The Sobo Taco Spot, LLC is a MD LLC and as of 12/09/2016 is active and in good standing.

(h) Posting Report: The location was posted on 11/23/2016 and checked on 12/3/2016. This meets the 10-day rule. There are 31 licensed liquor establishments in the 4x4 area: "B" BW-1; "D" BW-7; "A" BWL-2; "B" BWL-7; "D" BWL-5; "BD7" BWL-10.

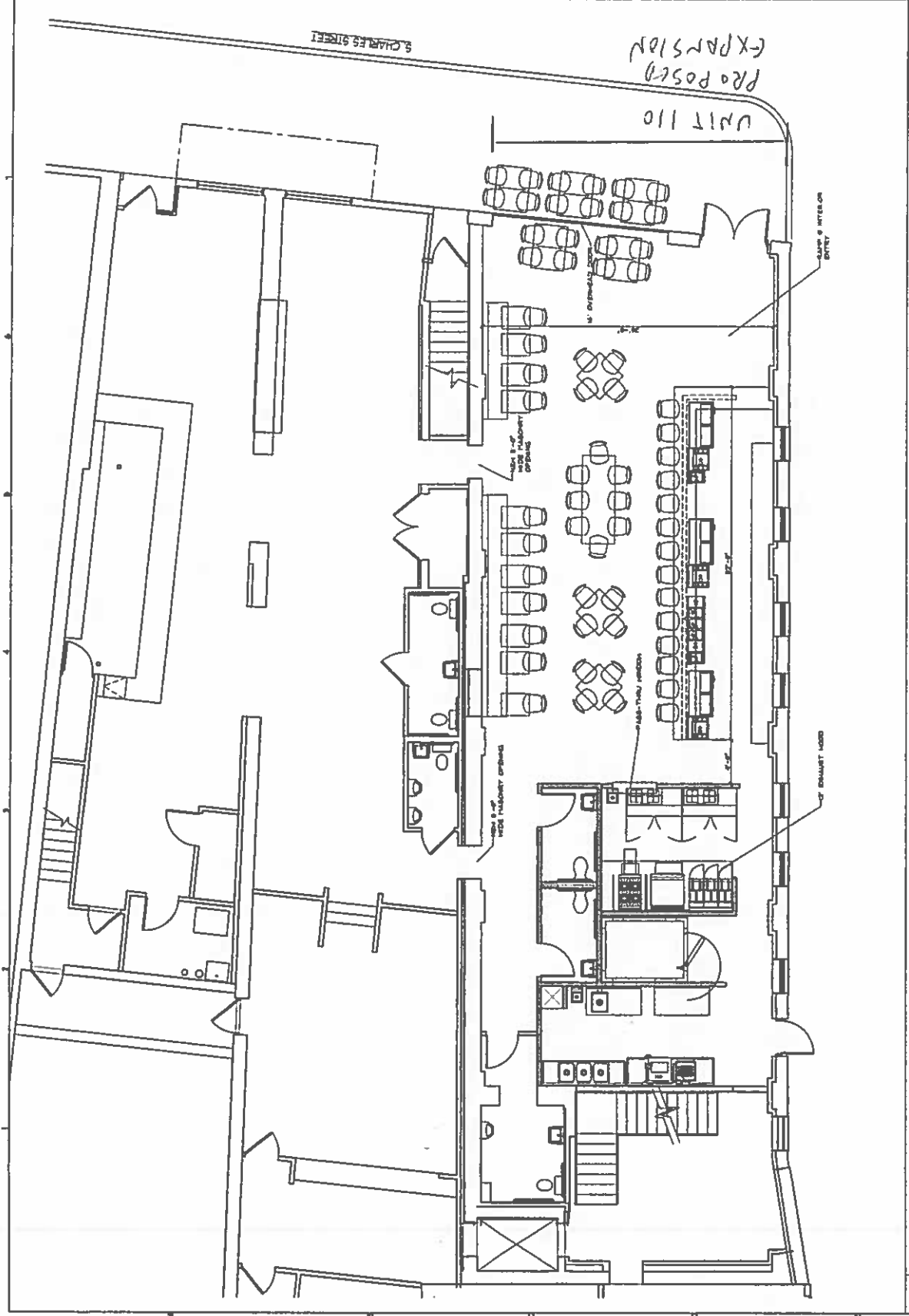

Couple with the lawsuit, two off the complainants in the lawsuit went out of their way to destroy the reputation of Four One Four and had contractors of the business attacked on the premises after they would leave out of Four One Four, which was operating under the trade name Kings and Diamonds.

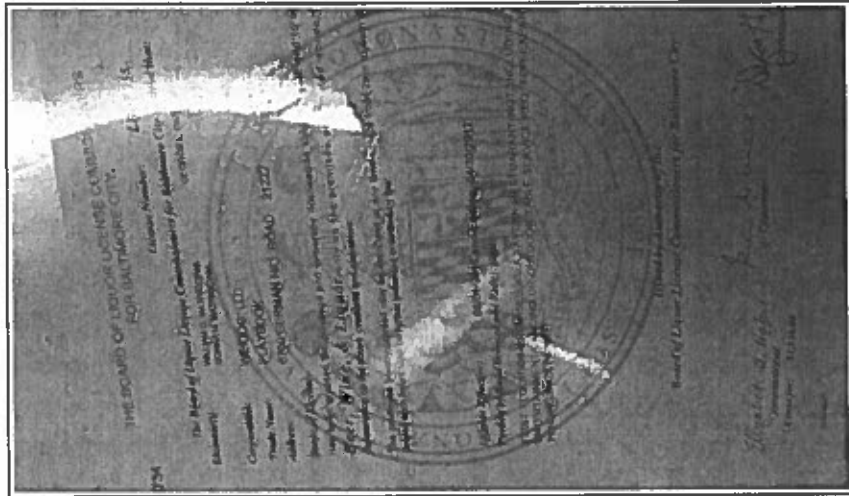

Location of Incident: T/A Jano Ethiopia, 34 South Eutaw Street, Baltimore, MD ("the establishment").

Violation of Rule 4.05 (a) and (b) Prohibited Hours – October 30, 2016 – At approximately 2:30 AM BLLC Chief Inspector Mark Fosler, Inspector John Howard, Inspector Andy Perez, Inspector Darryl Clark, and Inspector John Chrissomallis conducted a special investigation at the establishment. At this time, BLLC Inspectors Perez and Clark entered the establishment posing as patrons in an attempt to order an alcoholic beverage. Both Perez and Clark were granted entry to the establishment by security and walked to the bar area on the first floor. Perez and Clark observed "4 to 6" patrons, three of which were observed consuming alcoholic beverages. Inspectors then proceeded to upstairs lounge area. Upon reaching the lounge area, Perez and Clark observed approximately "20 to 30" patrons dancing and consuming alcoholic beverages. Perez and Clark then approached the bar in the lounge area and ordered two (2) bottles of Corona from the bartender. The bartender informed the Inspectors that the bar was closed. However, the licensee, Mr. Worku, who was present at the bar area and overheard the bartender deny the Inspectors request, instructed the bartender to serve the Inspectors. Inspector Perez paid \$10.01 for the two (2) bottles of Corona and was subsequently served by the bartender. While waiting for their alcoholic beverages, Inspectors observed another patron approach the bar and purchase shots of what seemed to be "Crown Royal Whiskey." Inspectors Perez and Clark left the establishment and then reported their findings to Inspector John Howard who entered the establishment and violated it for serving after hours.

Violation of Rule 3.02 Cooperation – October 30, 2016 – At approximately 2:30 AM BLLC Chief Inspector Mark Fosler, Inspector John Howard, Inspector Andy Perez, Inspector Darryl Clark, and Inspector John Chrissomallis conducted a special investigation at the establishment. At approximately 2:40 AM, Inspector Chrissomallis attempted to gain entry to the establishment in an effort to make contact with Inspector John Howard who was inside writing a violation to the licensee for operating after hours. Inspector Chrissomallis approached the location and attempted to gain entry to the location, but was greeted by the licensee, Mr. Worku, and a security guard. Inspector Chrissomallis identified himself as an Inspector with the BLLC and showed his agency issued identification and badge and requested entry to the establishment. Mr. Worku acknowledged who Mr. Chrissomallis was and then proceeded to become belligerent. Mr. Worku cursed at Inspector Chrissomallis and repeatedly denied him entry to the establishment. Inspector Chrissomallis informed Mr. Worku about Mr. Howard's presence within the establishment and the need to ensure that Mr. Howard's safety and then repeated his request to gain entry. Violation of Rule 2.13 Inspections – October 30, 2016 – At approximately 2:30 AM BLLC Chief Inspector Mark Fosler, Inspector John Howard, Inspector Andy Perez, Inspector Darryl Clark, and Inspector John Chrissomallis conducted a special investigation at the establishment. At approximately 2:40 AM, Inspector Chrissomallis attempted to gain entry to the establishment in an effort to make contact with Inspector John Howard who was inside writing a violation to the licensee for operating after hours. Inspector Chrissomallis approached the location and attempted to gain entry to the location, but was greeted by the licensee, Mr. Worku, and a security guard. Inspector Chrissomallis identified himself as an Inspector with the BLLC and showed his agency issued identification and badge and requested entry to the establishment. Mr. Worku stated to me "why was I persecuting a brother and that I should not violate him." I responded that this not a persecution but rather an enforcement of the Liquor Board rules and regulations requiring his business to close and cease operation between the hours 2am - 6am. Mr. Worku then continued a dialogue and stated "that we don't enforce the same rules against white establishments," which I assured him that the same rules and regulations apply to all licensees.

Chief Inspector Mark Fosler and Inspector John Chrissamaliss then entered and violations were written and we exited.

On 10/30/16 at approximately 2:20am Agent Howard and Inspectors Perez(Myself) and Clark responded to 34 S Eutaw St, Baltimore, MD 21201 to initiate an investigation based on complaints establishment was operating after regular mandated hours. Staff observed people coming in and out of establishment as well music playing. At approximately 2:25am Inspectors Perez and Clark gained entry to establishment through side door on W. Lombard Street, Inspectors were able to observed approximately 4 to 6 patrons on 1st floor bar where at least 3 patrons were consuming alcoholic beverages and at least 1 patron smoking hookah. After observing for a few moments, Inspectors proceeded to 2nd floor lounge where we were met by security/bouncer who proceeded to do a pat down of our body and stated " I don't need to check your ID's, just need to check you don't have no bang bang on you". Inspectors observed approximately an additional 20 to 30 patrons some which were dancing, consuming alcoholic beverage and smoking hookah. At this time Inspector Perez informed Agent Howard of observations through a phone call. At approximately 2:29am Inspector Perez & Clark proceeded to the bar and ordered 2 bottles of Corona to a female bartender, she stated "No, we are closed". However, licensee Mr. Worku instructed her to sell the beers for a total of \$10.01. At the same time another gentleman was observed purchased shots of what it seemed to be Crown Royal Whisky. Agent Howard entered the establishment at approximately 2:35am and identified himself as a Liquor Board Agent to the same female bartender who sold the beers to inspectors and requested to speak to the owner. At this time security staff started to clear establishment from patrons and inspectors Perez and Clark exited the establishment.

Report Facts:

On or about October 30, 2016 at approx. 2:20 am while on duty detailed to the Halloween Festivities in Fells Point I received a call from Chief Inspector Fosler that he was in route to Jano Ethiopia located at 34 Eutaw Street in the City of Baltimore and the State of Maryland. The Chief explained that 2 inspectors were inside in an undercover capacity and the establishment was open and operating well after 2am. I headed to the location and arrived at the same time as the Chief. When we arrived the 2 Inspectors had exited the establishment with the rest of the people in order to keep their cover. Agent Howard was inside the establishment Issuing the violations. Chief Fosler asked me to enter the location locate agent Howard and stay with him until he was finished. I walked up to the Lombard Street entrance where I was met by the licensee Mr. Worku and one security guard. At that time I identified myself and had my agency issued badge around my neck on the outside of my shirt and was visible. Mr. Worku said " I know who the F*** you are you violated me months ago for staying open after 2am. "I explained to the owner that violations are already being issued not by me and that I was there strictly for the safety of the Agent that was inside on the second level. He responded to me " Your not f***** going in you racist f***" I pulled on the door and it was locked. At that point I had serious concerns for the safety of Agent Howard. I told the owner that he was to give me access immediately. He again told me no and put his hand on my chest. I told the owner not to touch me and had to tell him multiple times. I believed that Mr. Worku was intoxicated with a strong scent of alcohol on his breathe and his eyes where glazed over after several minutes of trying to gain access to the property and the Agents safety a high concern I notified BCPD Central to send a patrol vehicle to assist me in gaining access. Right before the patrol car arrived Mr. Worku unlocked the door. I entered and went to the second level where I found Agent Howard along with 5 or 6 others individuals. I was approached by another security guard who identified himself as former BCPD. The Security guard was very professional and apologized for the owner's actions and said that he is not typically like that but he had been drinking that night. After Agent Howard was finished writing the violations we exited the location. I violated the licensee on the following:

1. 3.02 Cooperation
2. 3.08 Safety
3. 3.12 General Welfare
4. 2.13 Inspections
