PETITION TO PROTEST THE RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE AT OLD CLUBHOUSE

We, the undersigned residents and real estate owners in the immediate vicinity of Old Clubhouse, PROTEST the renewal of the liquor license for use by Old Clubhouse, located at 1809 Baker Street for the following reasons:

- Drug activity occurs both in and on the periphery of the establishment which is a "walking route" for the local elementary school and next to our new community park and farmer's market;
- Patrons regularly loiter and litter on the sidewalks and surrounding premises;
- Patrons engage in violent altercations in front of the establishment that spill out into the surrounding neighborhoods;
- Drug activity in and on the periphery causes traffic problems from people coming to buy drugs; and
- Patrons discard trash throughout the community, specifically bags and bottles.

Residents have concerns about safety in the neighborhood due to the high consistent frequency of drug dealers and outsiders simply hanging around the establishment. In the past year, residents have made numerous calls to 311 about the trash and litter and calls to the police because of disruptive activity at and in front of the bar. Responsible homeowners, community partners, and those who use that street (having to pass Old Clubhouse) for access to the elementary school, high school, community meetings, park, and farmer's market have a constant and growing concern for public safety. This community and its extension, in cooperation with the police in our district, oppose the renewal of Old ClubHouse liquor license.



- Patrons regularly loiter and litter on the sidewalks and surrounding premises;
- Patrons engage in violent altercations inside the establishment that spill out into the surrounding neighborhoods;
- Drug activity occurs both in and on the periphery of the establishment, and
- Patrons discard trash throughout the community

Residents have concerns about safety in the neighborhood due to belligerent and raucous patrons. In the past year, residents have made calls to the police because of disruptive activity at the bar. There are many other businesses in the area traffic becomes congested throughout the day with loud patrons taking up storefront and/or sidewalk space. The community organizations, and residents, in cooperation with the police in our district, oppose the renewal of Oxford Tavern liquor license.
