**MAYOR CATHERINE E. PUGH APPOINTS AND MARYLAND STATE SENATE CONFIRMS ELIZABETH
A. HAFEY TO THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR BALTIMORE CITY**

Baltimore, MD – Mayor Catherine E. Pugh appointed Elizabeth A. Hafey to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners of Baltimore City (Board) to fill the term of outgoing Commissioner Dana P. Moore, who recently resigned from the Board to become Deputy Solicitor of the Law Department for the City of Baltimore. On February 16, 2018, the Maryland State Senate confirmed Ms. Hafey's nomination to the Board.
