In the rear of the location, a separate room was being utilized to prepare the Hookah devices. Also, in the rear of the location, a DJ was observed playing music utilizing a turntable and mixer. Patrons were observed dancing near the front door in an area utilized as a "dance floor." Behind the bar, they found that the three-compartment sink was empty and there was no alternative way to sanitize glasses.

At the conclusion of the physical inspection, a check of the business records was performed. The establishment was unable to produce invoices for alcohol purchases. I spoke to the individual in charge, identified as Luna Sanchez by his Maryland driver' license, who disclosed that some of the recent purchases were made at a local liquor store. In addition, Mr. Luna informed them that he was not aware that live entertainment and hookah were not permitted. This Inspector issued numerous violations and left the location without incident.

Upon entering the establishment, BLLC noticed that the music was so loud that it shook the front door. They also saw several people smoking charcoal hookah and could see that the establishment was very smokey due to the amount of hookah being smoked. BLLC staff spoke to Mr. Alejandro Guitierrez and informed him that he would be receiving a violation. The staff left without incident.

On January 17, 2025, at approximately 11:18 pm a 311-Complaint was received alleging loud music at 501 S. Lehigh Street, also known as Gus's Sports Bar. Subsequently a second 311-Complaint for disturbing the peace was received at approximately 11:22 pm. At approximately 11:35 pm, BLLC Agent Perez, Agent Tudhope and Inspector Jordan arrived at the establishment and found excessively loud music emanating from inside the establishment. This establishment is in a residential area and surrounded by residential properties on all four sides. After making exterior observations, we proceeded to the interior of the establishment to inform the operator of the complaint received. Once inside the establishment, a Disc Jockey was observed performing with a laptop and amplified speakers. Additionally, a lit charcoal hookah was observed sitting on the bar top. 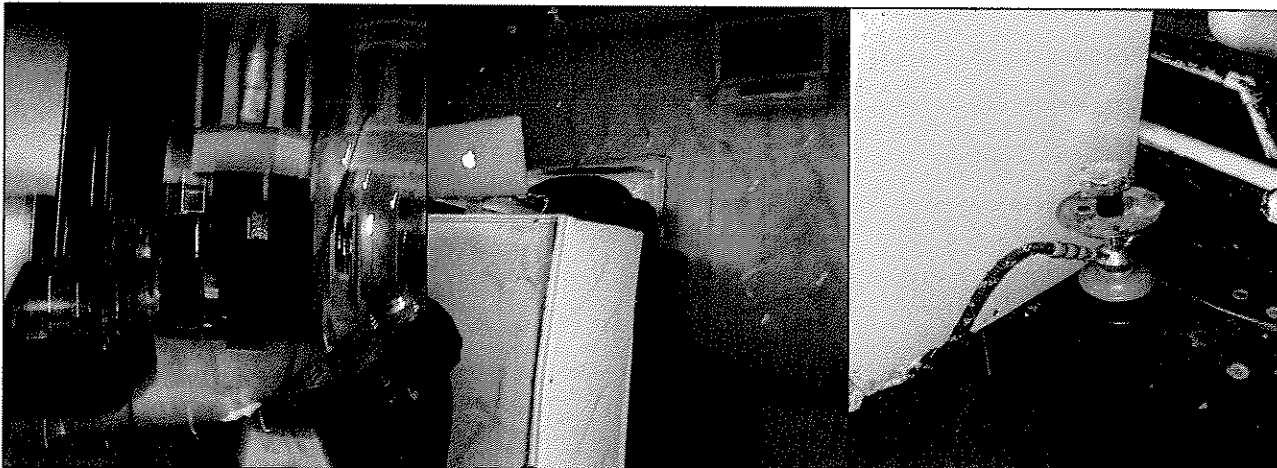

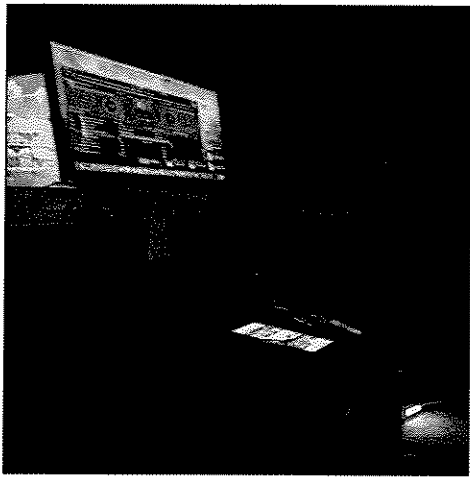

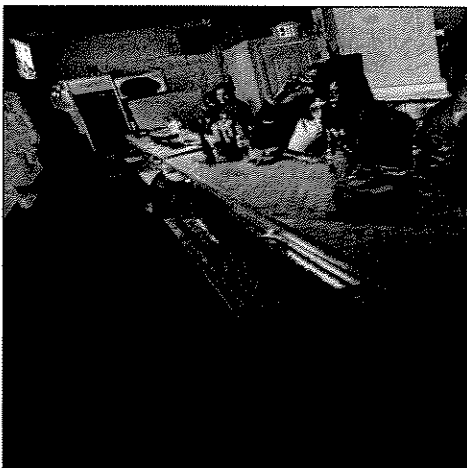
