(a) Licensee(s) Information: (1) Bing Chen; and (2) Yun Chen. The license transferred to the current ownership on 11/4/2015.

(b) Corporate Standing: Chen's Liquor, Inc. is a Maryland Corporation and as of 4/5/2018 is active and in good standing.

(c) Violation History for license year 2017-2018:

1. On March 1, 2018 the licensee(s) sustained violation(s) for the following charge(s):

- a. **Violation of Rule 4.01(a) Sales to Minors – December 19, 2017** – At approximately 10:15 PM, the Baltimore City Police Department and the BLLC conducted random, joint investigations of establishments to determine if licensees would sell alcoholic beverages to minors. The joint task force responded to the establishment and sent Baltimore City Police Cadet Charles Thomas, who is under the age of 21, into the establishment to attempt to purchase an alcoholic beverage(s). At that time Thomas entered the establishment and ordered pint of Seagram's lemon, strawberry, and watermelon. Utilizing a departmental \$20 bill, Thomas purchased the alcoholic beverage(s). Thomas then communicated to the task force that he had purchased an alcoholic beverage(s). Members of the task force entered the establishment and notified Mr. Lee Jones, the bartender/store clerk, sold an alcoholic beverage(s) to a minor and it would be reported to the BLLC. The task force then recovered the marked currency and returned both the alcoholic beverage(s) to the bartender and/or any change that was provided to Thomas.

Mr. Lee Jones, who was the attendant present at the location, told Akinwande "Yes" and then quickly changed his reply to "No," informing the detective that the bar was closed. Akinwande and Perez left the establishment and informed members of the Vice Unit and BLLC inspection division of the violation. Members from each team entered the establishment and informed Mr. Jones and Ms. Chen, the attendant(s) on location, of the violation of Rule 4.20(c)(ii).

3. On July 20, 2017 the licensee(s) sustained violation(s) for the following charges(s):

- a. **Violation of Rule 4.20(c)(ii) Class BD7 Licensees: Open and Operating Tavern at all Times – May 13, 2017** – At approximately 12:02 a.m., members of the Baltimore City Police Department's Vice Unit and members of the BLLC's Inspection Division conducted an investigation of this establishment due to numerous 311 complaints the agency had received regarding the location. Upon entry, BLLC Chief Inspector Mark Fosler and Agent Chrissomallis observed that the tavern portion of the establishment did not seem to be in operation. There were children's toys, a bike, and a stroller on or behind the bar. The liquor bottles behind the bar were dusty, the three-compartment sink was not in use, and no glasses or cups of any kind were in the bar area. Lastly, a bucket, mop, and snow shovel were in the customer area of tavern. As a result of the non-operation, BLLC staff advised Bing Chai Chen, the manager/licensee on location, of the violation of Rule 4.20(c)(ii).

This Protest of Renewal has been filed at least thirty (30) days before the license expires. Accordingly, the Board may not renew the license until it holds a public hearing.

1. **Uzo Nwosu and Obiefule Uwadineke, UZO, LLC, T/a Goodfellas Lounge, 4919 Belair Road** – Class "B" Beer, Wine & Liquor License – **Violation of Rule 4.05(a) – Prohibited Hours – December 3, 2017** – At approximately 2:30 AM the Baltimore City Police Department (BPD) and members of the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) conducted a special investigation at the location in response to anonymous complaints that the establishment was operating after hours. At this time, the BPD and DHCD attempted to gain entry into the establishment. While doing so, Det. Greenhill observed people inside the establishment. As patrons were exiting the rear of the establishment, DHCD Investigator Reiner was able to enter the establishment. Upon entry, Mr. Reiner observed patrons consuming alcoholic beverages. In addition, Mr. Reiner observed an individual leave the establishment with a half consumed bottle of beer. Det. Greenhill then gained entry to the establishment and observed the same. At this time Det. Greenhill noticed that both licensees, Mr. Obiefule Uwadineke and Mr. Uzo Nwosu, were located on the premises. Upon engaging in conversation, Mr. Uwadineke became argumentative with the BPD. At this time, the BPD informed the licensee of the violation and left the location.

As the president of the Valley Park Community Association our neighborhood has tried on many occasions to work with the owners of Good Fellas to end the loud music, unruly patrons, trash, patrons drinking outside of the bar, illegal parking issues and driving the wrong way on a one way street by their patrons to no avail. This establishment is open past 2:00 a.m. on many occasions. In addition to making all of these issues repeatedly

known to the owners we have also contacted 311 and 911. We ask the board to impose the legally most severe penalties for these violations.

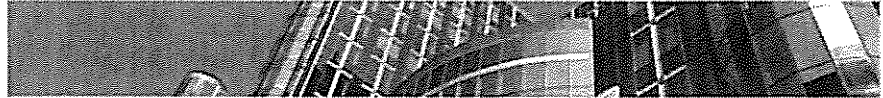
