Complainant stated that the music was "so loud that my house shakes, and I'm blocks away." BLLC staff arrived at the corner of W. Lafayette and Maryland Avenue which is approximately 220 feet away from the establishment, and they could hear music coming from the establishment at an elevated volume. They proceeded to the alleyway of the establishment and observed a disc jockey standing on the exterior staircase overlooking the patio performing with a full DJ setup including turntables, mixer, laptop and microphone and speakers. The establishment does not have outdoor live entertainment privileges on their license and received a violation for the same issue on March 1, 2025. Agent Tudhope also observed the dumpster to be overflowing and discarded chairs and tables in the alleyway. BLLC staff made contact with the manager and made him aware that the music was at an excessive volume and that they had observed the DJ outside. Establishment was instructed to end outdoor music, and they complied. Staff left the establishment without further incident and violation was issued. A recording of the noise level and DJ was also taken at establishment for violation.
