On 10 April 19 at 0025hrs(12:25am), Detective Greenhill along with members of ACS-Vice, as well as Liquor Agent John Chrissomallis from the Baltimore City Liquor Control Board, conducted an Underage Sales to Minor Investigation at the "Haven Place" located at 400-02 South Haven Street. Also working were Baltimore City Police Cadets' Nolan Klado and Jaziel Montanez both of whom were under the age of 21 at the time of this investigation. Cadets' Klado and Montanez whom were working in an undercover capacity, entered the "Haven Place" located at 400-02 South Haven Street, sat at the bar and purchased two(2) "Corona" Beers priced at \$5.00 each from Miss Kelly Marie Kilgore F/W/30, 06/1888. Cadets' Klado and Montanez paid using a departmental \$20 dollar bill. Cadet Klado then notified Vice Detectives and Liquor Agent Chrissomallis via text message that an alcoholic purchased had just been made.

Minutes later Vice Detectives along with Liquor Agent Chrissomallis entered the location identified as "Haven Place" and advised Miss Kilgore that she had just sold alcohol to underage police cadets'. Detective LeBrun recovered the departmental \$20 dollar bill and the change received was returned back to the establishment. Liquor Agent Chrissomallis photographed the "Corona" Beers. Detective Greenhill along with Liquor Agent Chrissomallis explained to Miss Kilgore that she would not be criminally charged for the underage sale, but an administrated report would be written up for the establishment. The establishment was left in the control of the Miss Kilgore.



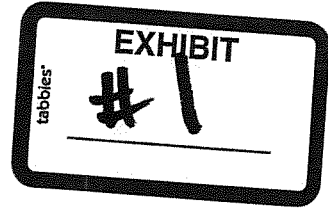

On 23 April 19 at 2100hrs(9:00pm), Detective Greenhill along with members of ACS-Vice, as well as Chief Inspector Mark Fosler and Liquor Agent Andy Perez, both from the Baltimore City Liquor Control Board, conducted an Underage Sales to Minor Investigation at "Stadium Lounge" located at 3351-53 Greenmount Ave. Also working were Baltimore City Police Cadets' E'Ian Brown and Michael Blackwell both of whom were under the age of 21 at the time of this investigation. Cadets' Brown and Blackwell, both whom were working in an undercover capacity, entered "Stadium Lounge" located at 3351-53 Greenmount Ave, which time Cadet Brown ordered a 375 ml of "Peach Amsterdam" vodka from employee, Miss Alicia Marie Brown, F/W/28, 03-91. Cadet Brown paid for the alcoholic beverage which was priced at \$7 dollars and \$.20 cents, using a departmental \$20 dollar bill and received change from Miss Brown. Cadets' Brown and Blackwell both exited "Stadium Lounge", with Cadet Brown carrying a black plastic bag in hand with the purchased alcoholic beverage and proceeded back to the vehicles where members of Vice and the Liquor Board were waiting.

Minutes later Vice along with the Liquor Board entered the location identified as "Stadium Lounge" and advised employee Miss Alicia Brown that she had just sold alcohol to an underage police cadet. Detective Lebrun recovered the departmental \$20 dollars and the change was returned back to the establishment. Chief Inspector Mark Fosler and Liquor Agent Perez conducted an inspection of the Tavern side of "Stadium Lounge" finding several violations. One(1) major violation observed by both Vice Detectives and the Liquor Board was a generator with gasoline in it, observed inside the bar of the establishment which is clearly a Fire code violation. Both Detective Greenhill and Chief Inspector Fosler advised another an employee on the scene, who was not identified at that time, to inform the licensee that the generator must be removed from inside of the premises. Liquor Agent Perez photographed the "Peach Amsterdam" vodka and returned it back to the establishment as well. Miss Alicia Brown was advised by Vice and the Liquor board that she would not be criminally charged for the underage sale, but an administrated report would be written up for the establishment. The establishment was left in the control of employee, Miss Alicia Brown.

On 23 April 19 at 2147hrs(9:47pm), Detective Greenhill along with members of ACS-Vice, as well as Chief Inspector Mark Fosler and Liquor Agent Andy Perez, both from the Baltimore City Liquor Control Board, conducted an Underage Sales to Minor Investigation at "Zen West Roadside Cantina" located at 5914-16 York Road. Also working were Baltimore City Police Cadets' E'Ian Brown and Michael Blackwell both of whom were under the age of 21 at the time of this investigation. Cadets' Brown and Blackwell whom were working in an undercover capacity, entered "Zen West Roadside Cantina" located at 5914-16 York Road, sat at the bar and Cadet Brown herself ordered one(1) "Corona" Beer from Miss Stephanie Erin Johnson F/W/23, 01/1996. The server, Miss Johnson served Cadet Brown the "Corona" beer but did not request payment at that particular time, which indicates Miss Johnson furnished the alcoholic beverage to Cadet Brown. Cadet Brown then notified Vice Detectives, Chief Inspector Mark Fosler, and Liquor Agent Perez via text messages that she had the alcoholic beverage in her possession.

Minutes later Vice Detectives along with Chief Inspector Fosler and Liquor Agent Perez entered the location identified as "Zen West Roadside Cantina" and advised Miss Johnson that she had just furnished alcohol to underage police cadet. As mentioned earlier, Miss Johnson did not request payment for the beer indicating the alcohol was furnished, so Detective LeBrun did not have to recover the departmental \$20 dollar bill. Liquor Agent Perez photographed the "Corona" beer. Detective Greenhill along with Liquor Agent Perez explained to Miss Johnson as well as the management working, that Miss Johnson would not be criminally charged for the furnished alcohol, but an administrated report would be written up for the establishment. The establishment was left in the control of Miss Johnson and the management on scene.
