You are hereby notified to appear before the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City at 10:30 o'clock AM on the 9th day of June 2022, at City Hall, 100 North Holliday Street, Room 215, Baltimore, MD 21202, to show cause why your Alcoholic Beverages License and other permits issued by this Board to you under the provisions of the Alcoholic Beverages Article, as amended, should not be suspended or revoked as required by this Board by Section 4-604 of said Article, following your conviction and/or violation of said law, to wit:

Location of Incident: T/A Club House Bar & Liquor, 4217 Erdman Avenue 21213 ("the establishment").

Violation of Rule 4.01(a) Sales to Minors – April 27, 2022 – On April 27, 2022, Board of Liquor License Commissioners (BLLC) Inspector Cindy Tudhope and Inspector Rosalba Jordan along with Baltimore Police Department Vice Unit (BPD Vice) Detective Lebrun and Sergeant Leisher conducted random, joint investigations of establishments to determine if licensees would sell alcoholic beverages to minors. Working as minors were Cadets Keyon Miles and Camron Lee Anderson, who at the time of the incident were both under the age of 21. Prior to the incident, a departmental \$20 bill was "marked" for identification via photograph to be traced as the cash used to make a purchase. At approximately 10:30pm, the two Cadets entered the establishment. The cadets purchased one (1) 22oz. bottle of Smirnoff Ice Mango flavored malt alcoholic beverage from the establishment, which they were sold by an employee for \$3.70. The Cadets paid for the alcoholic beverage using the marked \$20 bill, then exited the establishment with the alcohol and notified BLLC and BPD Vice of the sale. BLLC and BPD Vice then entered the establishment and contacted the seller, who was identified as Satish Chapagain, which they verified via driver's license. BLLC and BPD Vice informed Mr. Chapagain that he had sold alcohol to minor police cadets. The alcoholic beverage and the change from the transaction were returned to the establishment, and the marked \$20 bill was recovered by BLLC inspectors and BPD Vice. A BLLC violation was written up and all staff left the establishment without further incident.

If you fail to appear at the above location at the date and time as instructed by the agency, the Board will proceed with the hearing and will take such action regarding the suspension or revocation of your license and permits as warranted by evidence. If you have any questions concerning the specific rules or code cited, please refer to Rules and Regulations for the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City or the Alcoholic Beverages Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland for reference purposes. Violation Reporting Facts:

On April 27<sup>TH</sup>, 2022, Board of Liquor License Commissioners (BLLC) Inspector Tudhope and Inspector Jordan along with Baltimore Police Department Vice Unit (BPD Vice) Detective Lebrun and Detective Sergeant Leisher conducted random, Joint investigations of establishments to determine if licensees would sell alcoholic beverages to minors. Working with our two agencies in an undercover capacity were Police Cadets Myles and Anderson who at the time of this investigation were under the legal drinking age of 21. Prior to the investigation, a departmental \$20 bill was photographed so it could later be traced as the cash used to make the purchase.




Date Violation Issued:

At approximately 1030PM, the Cadets entered the establishment known as Club House Bar and Liquor located at 4217 Erdman Avenue. At this time, the Cadets were successful in purchasing a 22 ounce bottle of Smirnoff Ice Mango for a total of \$3.70 utilizing the \$20 bill from the named establishment. Following the purchase, the Cadets exited the establishment carrying the alcoholic beverage. Members of the BPD Vice Unit and BLLC then entered the establishment and contacted the seller who identified himself as Satish Chapagain DOB 02/ '1979 as verified by his MD Driver's License. BPD Vice Unit and BLLC members informed the seller that he had sold alcohol to underage police Cadets. The alcoholic beverage and change were returned to the establishment and the departmental \$20 bill was recovered.

BPD Vice Unit and BLLC members informed the seller that a violation report would be written up for the establishment. Both agencies departed the establishment without further incident.

On 4/27/22 at 2315 hours, members of the Baltimore city Vice unit and Baltimore city Liquor Board responded to 4217 Erdman avenue. The location is a liquor store know as Club House Bar & Liquor which is located within Baltimore city.

Along with the Baltimore city agencies were two Baltimore city police cadets, Keyon Myles age 19 and Camron Anderson age 19. While conducting an underage investigation, the two cadets entered Club House Bar & Liquor with departmental money and purchased 1 22oz bottle of Smirnoff. Same then exited the location and notified the Liquor Board Agents of the purchase.

At this time, Baltimore city Vice and Liquor Board entered the location and located the bar personnel who sold the alcohol to the Cadets. Same was identified via MD driver's license as Mr. Satish Chapagain. After the departmental money was recovered, the change from the purchase and the product was returned.

Mr. Chapagain was cooperative during the investigation and provided all necessary documentation requested. Same was informed that an administrative report would be written and forwarded to the Baltimore city Liquor Board for further review.
