

Report Facts:

On Friday, April 13, 2018 the Social Club Task Force (SCTF) was performing inspections at various establishments. On Saturday, April 14, 2018 at approximately 12:10am the SCTF inspected Birdland Sports Bar & Grill. The SCTF consisted of personnel from the BPD Vice Unit (Gatto, Greenhill), the Fire Dept. (Capt. Quarrels), Housing Code Enforcement (McGinnis), Health Dept. and Liquor Board (Clark, Chrissomallis, Fosler). Upon arriving at establishment staff noticed patrons outside. Patrons were going in and out of the front door. The patrons were loud and could be heard across four lanes of Belair Road. Upon entering staff heard loud music. A DJ was performing inside the establishment. The DJ was operating a complete sound system with large speakers, microphone, etc. The licensee was not at the location. Birdland employees contacted the licensee via telephone. Liquor Board staff asked for alcohol wholesaler invoices. These were never provided. No alcohol awareness certificate could be located. No employee records were provided. The Fire Marshall closed establishment at approximately 12:45am because of an expired Fire Permit.

Violations: Live entertainment without Liquor Board approval.

Purchasing alcohol from other than a licensed wholesaler.

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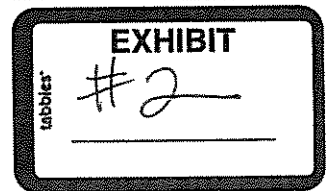

On 14 April 2018 at 0010hrs(12:10am), Detective Greenhill of IIS-Vice, Investigators from Baltimore Housing, Inspectors from the Health and Fire Department, and Inspectors from the Baltimore City Liquor Control Board all of which make up the Social Club Task Force, conducted an inspection at "Birdland Sports Bar & Grill" located at 6317-19 Belair Road. The above listed licensees were not present at the time of the investigation, but night manager Kenneth Lee Tyler was present and in full operational control of the premises. At the time of the investigation the bar was full patrons, some were drinking, others were eating as we noticed a full operational kitchen on the premises. At that point Detective Greenhill asked Mister Tyler for the Liquor License and all of the permits. Mister Tyler produced the Liquor License along with the Fire certificate and other permits that were available at that time. At that time Capt Quarles observed the current fire certificate to be expired and not up to date. He advised Mister Tyler to produce a current fire certificate, which he could not. At that point, Capt Quarles ordered the premises closed. Also on scene was Inspectors' Melanie Clark and Todd Ward from the Health Department and Inspector Clark informed Detective Greenhill of some major Health code violations that would result in the closure of the premises as well. In addition to the establishment operating without a current and up to date Fire Certificate, other fire code violations that were observed. A propane tank was found in the kitchen area and needed to be removed. The ansul system needed to be serviced and all cooking had to cease until the system was properly serviced. Any and all exit signs needed to be repaired and/or replaced. And the establishment could not open until properly inspected by the Fire Department. Inspectors' from the Health Department found the entire kitchen dirty, with uncleaned dishes to include pots and pans piled in the sink. A pot of used grease was observed sitting on the stove and a pot of grease was observed on a shelf with other food products. The grease trap was improperly used with a microwave sitting ontop of it. The entire kitchen area was unsanitary throughout which resulted in the closure by the Health Department as well. Investigator McGinnis from Baltimore Housing observed multiple electrical violations to include exposed wirings, an improperly mounted electrical panel, along with other electrical issues. Additional violations included, was dirty bathroom room vents, damaged floor tiles, cracked glass on the front door, and bulk trash and debris in the rear of the property. The licensee, Mister Casey Jenkins later arrived onscene after being notified by the night manager Kenneth Tyler. Each violations that was observed by Health, Fire, and Housing representatives was explained to Mister Jenkins. Furthermore, Mister Jenkins was advised that the establishment known as "Birdland" located at 6317-19 Belair Road would be closed until re-inspected by Health and Fire Departments. At that time the investigation was concluded and the premises was left in the control of licensee, Mister Jenkins.

At that time and place we were monitoring several clubs in the block with large numbers of people inside. Officer Dente and I were in front of 416 E. Baltimore, at a club called Club Downtown. We were getting a club count to see how many people were inside.

The front door swung open and we observed security guards putting a man, later identified as Mr. Brian Keith Morehouse, Jr. MW 06.1993, out of the club. When Mr. Morehouse was out of the club, the security guard went back in and a few moments later several more people including, Mr. Alvin Eugene Edwards, Jr. MB 08.1980, Mrs. Shaniqua Adrienne Arringer FB 09.1994, Mrs. Tamika Gayle FB 10.1982, Mr. Charles Robert Peters, III MB 09.1976, Mr. Javon Johnson-Leighton MB 12.1977, and Shantel Renee Christian, FB 11.1972, were also put out of the club. When this larger group came out of the club it appeared as though there was a lot of pushing and shoving going on. It also appeared that a fight was continuing. At that time, we all activated our BWC.

We began our attempts to separate the parties to figure out what had occurred. When we attempted to do that, our attention was drawn to Mr. Morehouse and Mrs. Arringer in a physical fight on the ground in the middle of the street. Mr. Edwards ran over and was apparently attempting to defend Mrs. Arringer by pulling her away from the fight. We were able to successfully separate Mr. Morehouse and Mrs. Arringer. It was obvious to us, that Mr. Morehouse was the aggressor and actively assaulting Mrs. Arringer with strikes from his hands/fists. Mr. Morehouse was placed into custody by Officer DeLucas and others. It was necessary to use a Level One force on Mr. Morehouse to get his hands behind his back.

Once Mr. Morehouse was in custody, Lt. Olson and other officers attempted to calm Mr. Edwards. Mr. Edwards continually stated that "He hit my niece." referring to Mr. Morehouse. Lt. Olson reassured Mr. Edwards that Mr. Morehouse was in custody and was going to be charged with the assault. It was also determined that Miss Jackson did not have security camera equipment around her business. Detective Greenhill asked Miss Jackson if she wouldn't mind closing once the Detectives and Patrols officers finish their investigation of the scene for public safety. Miss Jackson agreed, stating she was upset concerning the shooting at her business. Detective Greenhill left the establishment around 1am. The establishment identified as "Roots" was still in the control of DDU shooting Detectives. Eventually the establishment was left in the control of Miss Jackson.

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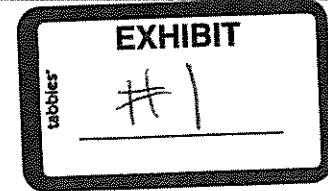

On 6 April 2018 at 2220hrs(10:20pm), Detective Greenhill of IIS-Vice, Investigators from Baltimore Housing, Inspectors from the Health and Fire Department, and Inspectors from the Baltimore City Liquor Control Board all of which make up the Social Club Task Force, conducted an inspection at "Club 2300" located at 2300 West Baltimore Street. The above listed licensees were not present at the time of the investigation, but night manager Marcus Antonio Clinton was present and in full operational control of the premises. As Agent Chrissomallis entered the establishment, he asked the night manager, Mister Clinton if the rear bar was open. Mister Clinton stated to Agent Chrissomallis that the rear bar area was closed. Agent Chrissomallis then conducted an inspection of the rear bar to find the various alcohol and food stock throughout the rear bar area. The three tub sink was not properly set up and beer stock and other non perishable food item were found behind the bar. At that point it was determined that the rear tavern was not open to the general public. Detective Greenhill along with Agent Chrissomallis advised Mister Clinton that if the package goods area is open to the general public, then too the rear bar area must also be open to the general public. Detective Greenhill then advised Mister Clinton that he is to close for one night only to clean and remove all stock from the rear bar area. Detective Greenhill also advised Mister Clinton to contact Mister Raj Kunwar Singh so we could inform him of the current situation. Mister Singh finally made contact with Mister Clinton by phone and he was advised by Mister Clinton that Vice was closing the establishment known as "Club 2300" only for the night so Mister Clinton could perform a proper cleanup and removal of all stock from the rear bar area. It was also determined that Mister Clinton could not operate the package goods and perform a clean-up of the rear bar area at the same time. Investigators from Baltimore Housing were also on scene and observed newly renovations being performed to an upstairs bar. Investigators from Housing will conduct a computer search to determine if the licensees and/or management obtained the proper work permits to perform the renovation work that was observed to the upstairs bar. At that time the investigation was concluded and the establishment was left in the control Mister Clinton.

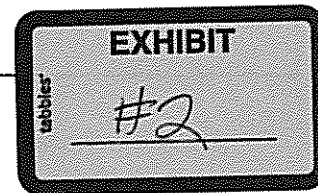

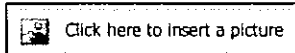

On 1/26/2018 at approx 2340hrs. Members of the Baltimore City Social Club Task Force responded to 6902 Harford Road, in reference to an inspection of Chesley Liquors. The task force consisted of 2 members of the Baltimore Housing unit, Captian Quarles of the BCFD, Agent Chrisomallis and Inspector Perez of the Baltimore City Liquor Board, and Sgt. Leisher, Det. Greenhill and Det. Gatto of the BPD VICE unit. Upon arrival your writer met with then night manager who was later identified with difficulty as Johnnie Robert Sammons. When meeting Mr. Sammons he immediately asked me if we were at the store to do an inspection because the city needed money. I told him no that is not the case, however we are here merely to do an inspection of the Liquor store and its permits. It was at this time I realized that Mr. Sammons was being extremely uncooperative with any and all investigators who were present at this inspection. Captain Quarles then asked Mr. Sammons to produce the stores fire permit. Mr. Sammons could not find or produce and information that was asked or needed by inspectors. At this time Captian Quarles of the BCFD closed the location under a cease and desist order. Other infractions found was some of the stock out front and in the rear of the location needed to be elevated off the floor. At this time the Liquor store was closed for business and would be followed up the next day by the BCFD. All events occurred in Baltimore City Maryland.
