- » Appearance in disarray, clothing stained
- » Balance unsteady, or body swaying, using a wall or furniture as a prop
- » Face pale or flushed
- Eyes bloodshot, red, or puffy
- » Fumbling or dropping of glass, ID, cash, etc., or misjudging distance
- » Unusual physiological symptoms, e.g., vomiting, excessive hiccupping, losing focus,

## sleepy or fainting

 All employees will be trained to maintain continual awareness of the level of intoxication of patrons, as well as whether individuals are buying drinks for others who may have in fact been cut off.

## **Procedures to Prevent Underage Drinking**

ID will be checked for every person seeking to enter the establishment who reasonably appears to be less than 30 years of age. There will be no exceptions made to this policy.

## Procedures for Maintaining an incident Log

Any time the police are called by the bar, a written summary will be entered into a written log.

## Procedures for Preserving a Crime Scene

Once an incident is deemed necessary to contact the police, the staff will ensure that no piece of potential evidence is disturbed.
