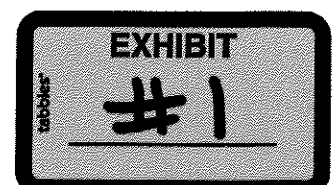

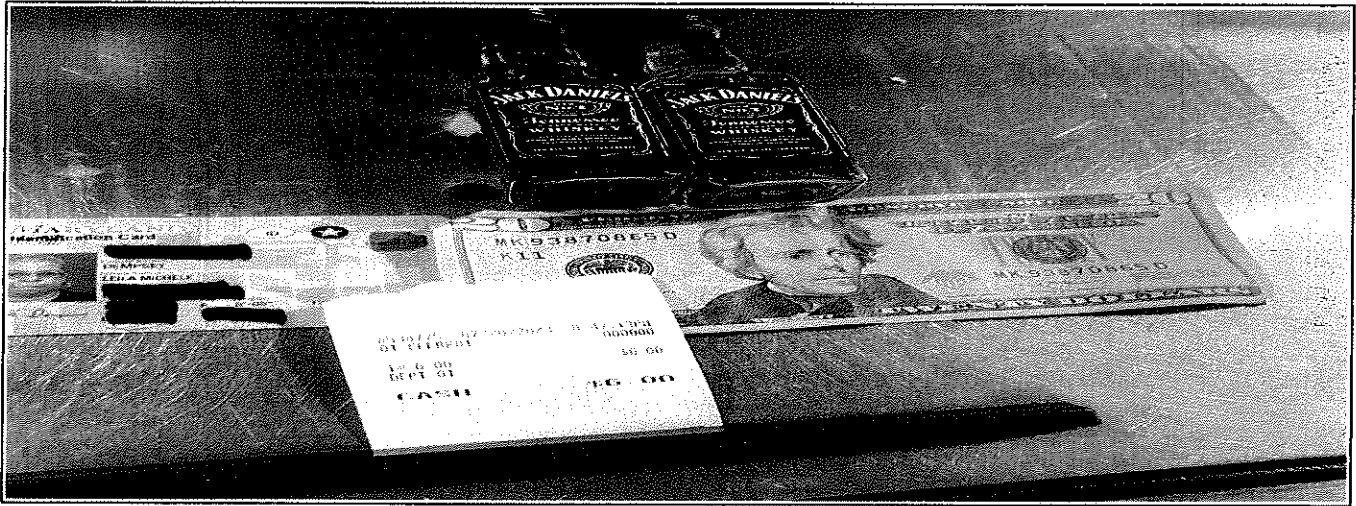
### Violation Reporting Facts:

On 7/20/23 I, Inspector Tudhope and Inspector Washington from the BLLC along with a members of Baltimore City Sheriff Office Special Operations Unit conducted underage alcohol sales to minors investigations throughout the City of Baltimore. Working with our two agencies in an undercover capacity were Cadet Carmen Gough all who at the time of this investigation were under the legal drinking age of 21.

At approximately 8:47 PM the units arrived at Club Bar Liquors located at 1609 Laurens St, to determine if the establishment would sell alcoholic beverages to an underage person. At this time Cadet Gough proceeded to the interior of the establishment and then purchased two Jack Daniels, 50 ml for \$6 from store employee who was later identified as Leila Michele Dempsey DOB 11/11/66. The Cadet notified the rest of the team that they had made a purchase. Moments later, we proceeded to the interior of the establishment and notified Ms Dempsey that she had just sold alcohol to underage Cadet. Inspectors issued Violation All members vacated the establishment without incident, and control of the establishment was returned to management. All events occurred in the city of Baltimore, State of Maryland.
