Violation of Rule 4.01(a) Sales to Minors - July 28, 2021 - On July 28, 2021, Board of Liquor License Commissioners (BLLC) Inspector Cindy Tudhope, Inspector Rosalba Jordan, Chief Inspector John Chrissomallis along with Baltimore Police Department Vice Unit (BPD Vice) Detectives Leisher, Gatto and Lebrun and Police Cadets J. Thomas and Jackson conducted random, joint investigations of establishments to determine if licensees would sell alcoholic beverages to minors. At the time of the incident, Cadets J. Thomas and Jackson were under the age of 21; cadets were given a departmental \$20 bill that was marked by photograph prior to any investigations commencing. At approximately 10:15pm, the joint agency task force entered the establishment. Cadets J. Thomas and Jackson ordered a single bottle of Bud Light Lime beer from the server, later identified as Jasmita Ahswinkumar Mangukia, for a total of \$2.85, which they purchased with the departmental \$20 bill. After the purchase, Cadets J. Thomas and Jackson exited the establishment carrying the alcoholic beverage in a bag. Moments later, Inspector Tudhope and members of the joint agency taskforce entered the establishment and contacted the server, Ms. Mangukia, who produced a Maryland driver's license verifying her identity. Inspector Tudhope and the task force informed Ms. Mangukia that she had just sold alcohol to an underage police cadet. The alcoholic beverage and the change from the sale were returned to the establishment; the task force recovered the departmental \$20 bill. Ms. Mangukia was advised that she would not be charged criminally, but that a BLLC violation would be written up for the establishment. BLLC Inspectors and BPD Vice left without further incident.

If you fail to appear at the WebEx Virtual Hearing as instructed by the agency, the board will proceed with the hearing and will take such action regarding the suspension or revocation of your license and permits as warranted by evidence. 


On July 28, 2021 at approximately 10:15PM I, Inspector Tudhope, Inspector Jordan and Chief Inspector Chrissomallis from the BLLC along members of BPD Vice Unit Detective Liesher, Detective Gatto and Detective Lebrun conducted underage drinking investigations

Thomas was given a departmental \$20 bill which was marked by a photograph prior to any investigations. Cadet J. Thomas and Jackson entered the establishment known as Mueller's Delli located at 7205-07 Harford Rd and Cadet Jackson purchased a single bottle of Bud Light Lime form the server who was later identified as Jasmita Ashwinkumar Mangukia for a total of \$2,85 utilizing the departmental \$20 bill. After the purchased, Cadet J. Thomas and Jackson exited the establishment carrying the alcoholic beverage in a bag. Moments later, myself along members of the taskforce entered the establishment and made contact with the server who was Identified as Ms. Jasmita Ashwinkumar Mangukia through a Maryland driver License provided to Task force. I and Members of Vice informed, Ms.Mangukia that she had just sold alcohol to underage police Cadet. The alcoholic beverage and change were returned to the establishment. The departmental \$20 Bill was recovered. Ms.Mangukia was advised that she would not be criminally charged but a violation report would be written up for the establishment. We departed the establishment without any further incidents.


