### Report Facts:

On or about September 24th 2016 at approx 12:30 am while on duty this inspector received a call from Det. Gatto from the Baltimore City Vice Unit informing me that Vice and BCHD was conducting an inspection at Main Street Liquors located at 3724 Eastern Ave in the City of Baltimore and the State of Maryland. This inspector was a few blocks away and went to the location and parked directly across the establishment and observed activities. At approx 12:50am I observed 3 individuals (2) Hispanic Males and (1) Hispanic Female approach security that was directly outside the front door. One of the males wearing a Gray shirt handed security what seemed to be an ID. The other male and female had a brief conversation with the security and nothing was handed to him. After a few seconds the security guard went inside and came back out with a second guard. At that time the second guard had a brief exchange with the two individuals and allowed them to enter. At approx. 01:00 am I entered the establishment with BCPD Vice and Health. While Det. Greenhill and the 2 inspectors from health met with the owner and manager Det. Gatto and myself went in the back of the establishment to attempt to locate the 3 individuals that I believed were under age. After a few min we located the Female and Male waiting to be served at the bar. After the bartender served the 2 individuals (a Bucket of Corona Beers) we followed them to a Hightop table where the third individual was waiting. We Identified ourselves and asked to see Identifications. The one male that witnessed earlier handing what I thought was an identification card did have ID stating we was over the age of 21. The 2 other individuals did not have ID and we asked them to follow us to the front of the establishment. We asked the male for ID and he stated he did not have any on him. When asked what his birthday was he stated 11/1996 which makes him the age of 20 years old. The female said she was 23 years old however could not provide us with an age that she was born. She told us her ID was in the car and went to get it. The female fled and never returned. The male gave a name of Haviar H. Diaz with a birthday of 11/1996. The female had given a name of one Michelle Calvera Gevea. We asked the security why these 2 individuals where allowed to enter the establishment and drink and they stated that they where given a green bracelet to identify them under 21 and should not have been allowed to drink and they took it off. I explained to security that it should be reversed and a bracelet should be given to those 21 and over and it should be verified by the bartenders that individuals have a bracelet in order to be served. Security acknowledged their mistake and were cooperative with inspector and Detective. I notified the owner that he was in violation of Sales to Minor and Minor in possession of alcohol. Owner was also cooperative with Inspector and Det. we left the location without any further incident.

Members of the BPD Vice Unit along with Liquor Inspector Chrisimallis and two members of the Baltimore City Health Department, were conducting a social club task force detail in the southeast District of Baltimore City, Maryland. Your writer, Det. Gatto along with Det. Greenhill responded with the health department to the address known as 3724 Eastern Ave, known as Main Street Bar and Liquors. Upon arrival of this location, Inspector Chrisimallis observed 3 patrons approaching the security employee who was standing at the front door of Main Street Bar and Liquors. Inspector Chrisimallis observed only one of the patrons showing the security employee identification in effort to enter the bar. Inspector Chrisimallis and I were able to memorize the clothing description of each of the three patrons who were able to gain entry to the bar. The first was a male wearing a gray shirt and blue jeans, the second was a male with a black hat, and black shirt with a large Adidas logo on the front of the shirt. The third was female wearing a black and white striped shirt with shorts. Upon entry of the bar, only the male with the gray shirt displayed his identification. Once inside the bar, Inspector Chrisimallis and I were able to locate the male with the black hat and the female with the white and black shirt. Both were standing at the bar order drinks. The male with the hat and large adidas logo was holding currency in his hand and exchanged same with the bar tender for a bucket of Carona beer's. At this time the male (black hat, adidas logo) who was identified as Javier Hernandez Diaz 11/1996 of [redacted] and the female (black and white striped shirt) later identified as Michelle Calvera Gevea Dob unknown, walked towards a table with the Javier Hernandez carrying the bucket of Carona's. At this time your writer and Inspector Chrisimallis approached Mr. Hernandez and Miss Gevea. I asked for their photo identification to verify their age. Mr. Hernandez said he had no identification and Miss Gevea said her identification was in her vehicle. Mr. Hernandez advised me his DOB was 11/1996 which makes him 20 years old. At that time Inspector Perez instructed Mr. Farantos to obtain a 2016 Trader's license within 10 days and also to have alcohol purchase invoices ready and available for Inspector to review.

On 9/1/16 Inspector Perez contacted Bond Distributing and spoke to Ms. Cathy to obtain purchase records for G & A restaurant. During this phone call inspector Perez was informed that G & A's account was closed in 2014 due to inactivity and their last purchase was on 6/24/2009, Invoice #426008 for 2 cases of Coors light and two cases of Miller Lite totaling \$66.00. Inspector Perez also contacted Cheasepeake Beverage on 9/1/16 for to obtain purchase records for G & A Restaurant and found that they didn't have an account set up nor had any purchase records in their system for this business.

On 9/2/16 Inspector Perez returned to G & A Restaurant, at this time Inspector Perez asked Mr. Farantos if he had obtained a 2016 Trader's and Mr. Farantos only showed documents pertaining a collection agreement between The Baltimore City Law Department and G & A Restaurant. (Pictures of agreement on file). Inspector Perez also asked Mr. Farantos to see alcohol purchase invoices for the last six months and again Mr. Farantos stated he didn't have any invoices. Then, Inspector Perez asked him where he purchased his beers; Mr. Farantos stated "next door" referring to Bayview Liquors, located at 3804 Eastern Ave. At this time Inspector Perez informed Mr. Farantos that a violation was being issued for purchase from other than a licensed wholesaler and for operating without a 2016 Trader's license.
