On October 13, 2016, Judge Alfred Nance of the Baltimore City Circuit Court reversed the Board of Liquor License Commissioner's decision, made on June 23, 2016, to refuse to renew the license issued to this establishment and ordered that the case be remanded back to the Board and that a new protest of renewal hearing be held in this matter.
