**BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS PUBLISHES PROPOSED RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR RELATED EVENT PROMOTER'S PERMITS FOR CIAA TOURNAMENT**

Baltimore, MD – As per Alcoholic Beverages Article 12-1102.2 (g), the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City (BLLC) is authorized to adopt rules and regulations concerning the Related Event Promoter's Permit for the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association. With publication of these proposed rules and regulations on this day, January 24, 2020, the BLLC is providing 30 days for public comment concerning its draft.

At 11:59 pm on February 22, 2020, the BLLC will close the comment period to the public and review all suggested amendments, modifications, and additions to the proposed rules and regulations. On or after February 25, 2020, the BLLC shall publish a final draft of the rules and regulations. Following their publication, the Board shall adopt the rules and regulations before the start of a scheduled public hearing. Upon adoption by the Board, the rules and regulations shall become effective.
